

Indigo 12 Foot Yurt

Specs:

Diameter – 12 feet
Circumference – 37.7 feet
Floor space – 113.1 square feet
Wall height – 6 feet
Floor to crown – 10 feet
Wall sections – 2



Our 12 foot Yurt is just the perfect size for folks who plan on traveling or are limited on space. This yurt is easily adaptable in setup to fit into a size of 108sq.ft making it idea for anyone restricted by local building codes.

The walls are made from kiln dried Canadian spruce and tied using 1/8" diameter nylon braded rope for maximum strength. Roof poles are hand cut and peeled from sustainably harvested hardwoods, primarily maple and oak. The roof poles tie into the wall by resting on a 1/16" diameter aircraft cable running the circumference of the Yurt which has an individual load point breaking strength of 480lbs. A circular or lightweight octagonal crown is available and can be painted nearly any colour. Our Yurts come with a custom sewn canvas cover using 10oz waterproof, rot and mildew resistant and fire resistant marine grade canvas. An additional UV protected poly shell is also provided to help extend the life of the Canvas. Additional features are easily added in such as windows & stove jack.



Indigo 14 Foot Yurt

Our 14 foot Yurt is new to our catalog for 2018, this yurt is a bit bigger then our 12 foot yurt allowing folks more room yet the overall travel size and time for setup stays relatively the same. The extra 40+ square feet floor space really shows when there is to be any furniture in the Yurt. If you are looking for that extra space for travel, guests or as a personal place for yoga and meditation our 14 foot Yurt makes that perfect space.

The walls are made from kiln dried Canadian spruce and tied using 1/8" diameter nylon braded rope for maximum strength. Roof poles are hand cut and peeled from sustainably harvested hardwoods, primarily maple and oak. The roof poles tie into the wall by resting on a 1/16" diameter aircraft cable running the circumference of the Yurt which has an individual load point breaking strength of 480lbs. 

Indigo 20 Foot Yurt

Circumference – 62.8 feet
Floor space – 314.16 square feet
Wall height – 6 feet
Floor to crown – 12 feet
Wall sections – 3



The walls are made from kiln dried Canadian spruce and tied using 1/8" diameter nylon braded rope for maximum strength. Roof poles are hand cut and peeled from sustainably harvested hardwoods, primarily maple and oak. The roof poles tie into the wall by resting on a 1/16" diameter aircraft cable running the circumference of the Yurt which has an individual load point breaking strength of 480lbs. This Yurt only comes with the option of a circular crown and can be painted nearly any colour. Our Yurts come with a custom sewn canvas cover using 10oz waterproof, rot and mildew resistant and fire resistant marine grade canvas. An additional UV protected poly shell is also provided to help extend the life of the Canvas. Additional features are easily added in such as windows & stove jack.

Basic Yurt Features



WALLS

Our lattice walls are made from kiln dried Canadian spruce and tied together using 1/8" nylon braded rope, our 12 and 14 foot Yurts come with two sections and our 20 foot comes with three.



Roof Poles

On our 12-foot and 14- foot yurts we use hand cut and peeled roof poles made from hardwoods sustainably cut from our farm in Northern Ontario.



On our 20-foot Yurts we use kiln dried dimensional lumber for extra strength over the larger spans. (Natural poles can be used on the 20-foot yurt with special request)



Tension Cable

We use a 1/16" 7x7 braded aircraft cable as the tension band and where our roof poles tie into the wall. Aircraft cable is incredibly strong and has an individual load point breaking strength of 480lbs.



Door

We custom make our doors to fit the shorter height of the Yurt. We can add a glass window as an additional feature, and paint it a custom colour.



Coverings

Each yurt is covered with a 10.10oz marine grade canvas which is water proof, rot and mildew resistant, and fire resistant.



Additionally, a UV protected Poly covering is also provided with our Yurts as a protective covering helping to extend the lifespan of the canvas.





Crown

The option of a circular crown of octagonal crown is available, the difference is in the size and weight. The circular crown is larger, heavier and easily equipped with a dome skylight. The octagon crown is much lighter and is more suited for Yurts which will be disassembled and reassembled often.

Yurt upgrades



Windows

Windows can be added to any size of Yurt, the addition of a window gives your Yurt an abundance of light negating the need for supplemental lighting during daylight hours.

Our windows are made from transparent heavy duity marine plastic which can tolerate the cold winter temperatures.

Each window is attached via Velcro allowing for easy opening for ventilation during the warmer months. The window has a mesh screen sewn in place to prevent bugs from entering the Yurt.

Add a window to your Yurt for an additional \$250.00 on the total price of the Yurt.

Add a window to your door for an additional \$120.00 on the total price of the Yurt.



Stove Jack

A fireproof stove jack can be added so that any Yurt can be equipped with a woodstove. 4", 5" and 6" hole sizes available

Add a Stove Jack to your Yurt for an Additional \$150.00 on the total price of the Yurt.





Insulation

Astro-foil is a radiant barrier insulation, and works Astro-foil's main defence is reflecting radiant heat. It reflects up to 97% of all radiant heat. Reflective insulation has different R-values because of the effects of convection in the air space where its located. The air movement varies with the direction of heat flow (summer/winter). Astro-foil's R-value is expressed as follows:

Down Heat flow...... R - 15Side heat flowR - 7.3Up heat flow.....R - 5.4

Felt insulation is a all natural material made from matting wool fibers together.

We use 1/4 " felt for our yurts and it gives the Yurt a really nice feeling.

Felt is highly resistant, fire retardant and self extinguishing and water repellent.

Felt has superior thermal insulating properties.

Wool is a renewable and environmentally friendly resource.

Floors and platforms

We offer floor and platform building services for any size of Yurt and location. We also offer free plans for anyone who would like to build their own platform for their Yurt to be assembled on. There are many options for the floor of a Yurt, it can be raised, insulated, stained or painted. Plywood or 12" wide pine is what we recommend for the floor built upon a traditional raised platform.
